
The Coronavirus Crisis


The second reason is that you can have a horse or maybe even more. The horse could be of great use in

Valorant

Valorant is a new first person shooter (FPS) and a hero shooter (same concept of a shooter except you also have abilities with cooldowns) game made by Riot Games, the same company that created the widely known MOBA (multiplayer online battle arena), *League of Legends*. The game is in its closed beta, meaning that it is not finished yet and is not available for everyone. The only way to get the game at the moment of writing this, is by watching a stream on the popular streaming platform Twitch that has the "drops enabled" tag, for a minimum of two hours, and then wait until you get a notification that you received the game.

Valorant is very similar to *Counter-Strike: Global Offensive* (CS: GO), another FPS made by Valve. The game also has an economy system, receiving money for each round you play up to a maximum of 16.000, money which you can use to buy weapons, shields which reduce damage taken, and abilities.

Overall, I would say the game is quite good and a lot of fun to play with your friends, so if you get lucky and receive it, give it a shot.

In the first episode, he sabotages the horse races and tricks people for his own gain. Tommy is a very intelligent man, and has everything planned ahead... Well, almost everything. While in a pub, he learns from a friend that a new police chief is coming to town, with ill-intent for the Peaky Blinders. At the time, they were the leading gang in their part of

Birmingham, and the major Chester Campbell wanted to change that. Another factor that influenced Major Campbell into accepting the job to come here was the fact that it was said that the Peaky Blinders stole guns from the British Government, guns that were meant to go to Libya. What actually happened was some of Tommy's men were drunk while on a mission to steal some horses, and accidentally brought a crate full of weapons with them. Chester Campbell's arrival was very important in the Shelby's family rise to glory.

The first 2 seasons heavily involve Major Campbell, while showcasing the degrading state of Tommy's mental state and increasing paranoia and suspicion of his peers. At the end of the second season, Campbell is killed by Polly Gray and that chapter of the Peaky Blinders comes to an end, with the Shelbys being one of the leading gangs from all of Birmingham. Tommy Shelby desperately wants to go legal, trying to leave behind the gangster life he once cherished, but is unable to because of his money-hungry alter-ego. He ventures into London to expand his influence, but hits a dead end when he angers the strongest gang in the city. He allies with the second most powerful gang and befriends its Jewish leader, Alfie Solomons, played by Tom Hardy. After getting over their differences and multiple backstabs from the Jewish leader, they manage to defeat the rival gang, the Shelbys becoming one of the strongest gangs in all of England. In all these years, they became a race organizer, legal gin producer and feared gangsters. Tommy Shelby even got noticed by The King and Winston Churchill, reaching a power never even thought of by other gangsters. He proceeds to do missions for His Majesty, in exchange for political favors, ranks and

more influence. While juggling between The King's requests and his personal interests, Tommy kills the father of a very important man. That man being the leader of the Italian Mafia from New York. Hearing of his father's death, Luca Changretta travels to Birmingham to avenge his father. This is Tommy Shelby's greatest challenge yet, but he manages to defeat The Mafia and becomes even stronger.

This power he earned during the years didn't do all good, because Tommy Shelby became an unrecognizable man, compared to his past self. He would only tell certain people about his plans, sometimes not even trusting his own brothers because of the amount of times he was backstabbed and betrayed. All the characters have great personalities and fleshed out ideas, never being too easily forgotten. While some subplots were dragged out a bit too much, The Peaky Blinders managed to remain extremely interesting, unique and grandiose, with much suspense and appeal during the first 4 seasons. Unfortunately, the show took a turn for the worst in the 5th season. Don't get me wrong, the last season currently available is good, but an undeniable downgrade from the last 4 seasons can be seen. The last season explores Tommy Shelby's life as a politician and undercover agent for the British Government. His mission is to stop the Marxist movement in Birmingham and London, but he gets involved in Fascism and prioritizes bringing down a quite influential fascist man. He manages to get close to him, forming a symbiotic relationship, realizing what kind of a man this fascist is. He describes him as sick, only caring about his own interests, lying to the people he is trying to get on his side. Tommy wants to remove this ill man from the face of the earth, planning an assassination. In probably the most suspenseful scene of the show, the assassination fails, the assassin is killed and Tommy and his brothers barely escape alive. The catch is that the fascist had no idea this happened. So they went on with the day as if nothing happened, Tommy not knowing who sabotaged his plans. At the end of the last episode, we see Tomas Shelby having a mental-breakdown over not being right for once in the last 10 years, and having no idea who could have done this to him. The last scene leaves us in a cliffhanger, showing the main character with a gun to his head, implying that he might kill himself.

In conclusion, "Peaky Blinders" is a wonderful, slow and somewhat dark show that is worth watching for its unbelievable story, terrific characters, formidable soundtrack and eerie atmosphere all throughout the 5 seasons.

Dying Light – review

One of the games I've started playing during this "break", and also one of my favourite games I've played in a long while is "Dying Light", so I thought this game would be a nice subject to review.



Dying Light is an open-world-zombie-survival game that has a thrilling story and also impressive parkour elements. It takes place in the fictional town of Harran, the center of the zombie-virus' outbreak, sealed off from the outside world. So, the town is filled with zombies, along with some small communities of survivors left.

Our hero Kyle Crane, a military operative working for an organization called GRE is parachuted in Harran, with a mission, to recover sensitive data about the disease, stolen by a GRE man who has gone "wild". The action gets off to a challenging start, when Kyle gets immediately bitten by a zombie, but luckily a bunch of survivors rescue him and take him back to their safehouse. There, he is taught parkour skills, which are a very important part of the game, given that in Harran there are no other ways to travel but on foot. You're told very early in the game that noise attracts zombies, so you are meant to take a "sneaky" approach to the game (which means that guns and explosives have a huge drawback), even though it can be played in a very loud style too. The story is about Kyle's objective, to recover that important data while helping the communities with tasks such as repairing antennas and fighting many threatening creatures.

One thing this game can teach is how much the perspective means. In the later stages of the game, Kyle is learning more about himself and the actual state of the world he lives in, but the exact details remain for YOU to unveil while playing this awesome game!

In the end, I would like to give my own opinion of this game. I really appreciated the mechanics of the game, which weren't even close to perfect, but while playing this game I really felt like there was a learning curve in everything, from parkour moves to attacking enemies. 


