C. BACKG	ROUND AND EXPERIENCE	
Brief presentation of the organisation	We are a secondary school in Satu Mare, Romania. We currently have 756 students, aged 11-19 (most of them with an urban background, some of them from surrounding rural areas) and 55 teachers. There are 4 middle school classes (grades 5 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> ) and 23 high school classes (9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> ), with various specializations: Mathematics-Computer Science, Philology, Natural Sciences, Social Studies and Pedagogical (kindergarten and primary school teachers). Some of them have intensive IT and English classes. The languages taught in our school are English, German and French, and all our students and teachers are computer literate. Even though we do not have experience with Erasmus+projects yet, we were involved in several Comenius projects some years ago on Film-making (and we currently have Film studies optional classes) and Sustainable Environment (protecting the environment and the endangered species).	

	We are extremely energetic, ready to take up new challenges, and always eager to discover and learn new things, to broaden our horizons. Therefore, we are interested in joining Erasmus+ strategic partnerships, providing our students with the opportunity to grow on a personal, social and cognitive level. Our students' and teachers' well-being represents a priority for us, and we foster and promote tenets such as mutual understanding, respect and support. We do our best to create a friendly, safe, and comfortable learning environment so that both our students and our staff feel valuable and valued.
Activities and experience of the organisation	We are part of the World Eco-School Programme, we are a Cambridge Assessment Closed Centre and a Cambridge Pretest Centre, we have great accomplishments with our Robotics clubs and with our sports teams (volleyball, basketball, football, table tennis, chess), and most of our students pass their ECDL exams before graduation. Also, we are a Microsoft-accredited school, and we carry out online and blended-learning activities successfully.
	We have a very active Student Body Council and great support from our Parents' Association. Many students are members of the Students' Club, School Radio Team, Art Club, School Choir and Film and Photography Club.
	We are regularly involved in volunteering and bring our contribution to both charitable and ecological campaigns. A lot of our students have notable academic achievements, take part in competitions and olympiads, and further attend higher education institutions.
	We have established solid partnerships with various institutions from our local community: the City Hall, The Art and History Museums, the Public County Library, The local Cultural Centre, the Local School Safety Office, the Centre for Anti-drug Prevention, Assessment and Counselling, with the Lawyers' Bar, NGOs etc.
Skills and expertise of key staff	Alina Dragoș is the Principal of our school. She has been teaching Romanian for over 20 years and she has 6 years of experience in school management. She has organised a series of contests and ceremonies in our school and at county level, and she has also coordinated school magazines.

	Ionela Manda is the Vice-principal of our school. She has been teaching English for 13 years and she is also a teacher trainer. She has solid experience in coordinating and implementing projects and extra-curricular activities, she is carrying out research work in language acquisition, and takes part in international conferences and trainings.
	We are all very involved in closely working with students, and find joy and fulfilment in helping them evolve and become self-reliant young people.
